Bill No. 28-0087 – An Act amending title 15 V.I.C., relating to the affairs of decedents and relating to the affairs of fiduciaries, enacting the Virgin Islands Uniform Probate Code and for other purposes Action

Bill No. 28-0104 – An Act amending title 29 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 1, subchapter II, section 32 (a) by reducing the number of Commissioners from nine to seven

Bill No. 28-0137 – An Act amending 31 V.I.C, chapter 23, section 236a to prohibit the requirement of surety on bids that are \$150,000 or less and for other purposes

Bill No. 28-0142 – An Act amending 3 V.I.C., section 530(a) as it relates to wrongfully discharged government employees

Bill No. 28-0158 - An Act amending 12A V.I.C., enacting the Virgin Islands Uniform Debt Management Services Act

Bill No. 28-0168 - An Act amending 3 V.I.C., chapter 25, subchapter V, section 555b to provide for minimum wage employees of semi-autonomous agencies and independent instrumentalities of the Government

Bill No. 28-0183 – An Act amending title 22, Virgin Islands Code, to add chapter 66, to enact the Alternative Markets Act, to facilitate asset-backed securities transaction, to provide for special purpose financial captives, and for related purposes
