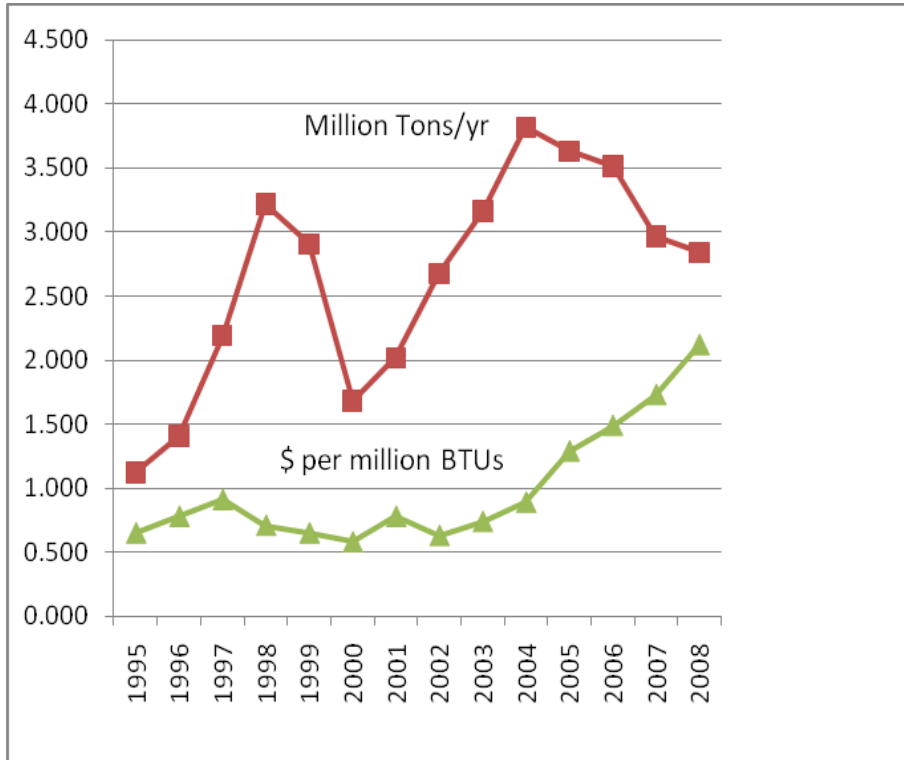


Quantity and Cost of Petroleum Coke Received by United States Electricity Utilities, 1995-2008
